

Maintenance Instructions

◆ ABH General Product Instructions ◆

1. Occasionally check the fasteners and tighten if necessary. The fasteners should not loosen regularly. If they do, please check for improper installation that may need to be resolved.
2. Cleaning the product routinely extends the life: Following the cleaning instructions below, separated by finish.

◆ ABH Continuous Hinge Product Maintenance ◆

1. No additional lubrication is required
2. An occasional removal of airborne debris may be accomplished with a mild detergent; this will help maintain the finish.
3. Hinge screws should be periodically inspected for tightness in high traffic areas.

◆ ABH Electro-Magnetic Door Holder Product Maintenance ◆

1. Cleaning the magnetic coil or contact plate, use only a fine emery cloth with the power turned off.
2. Cleaning the cover or door armature base follow the general product instructions for the specified finishes.

***Always try the recommended cleaning procedure below in a small inconspicuous area prior to cleaning the entire unit to ensure you are pleased with the results.*

Finish Code	Finish Description	Cleaning Instructions
US10	Satin Bronze, Lacquered	Use a soft cloth, mild soap and water. Do not use brass polish or an abrasive cleaner unless you want to remove all lacquer and totally refinish the product.
US10B	Oil Rubbed Bronze, Oxidized	Use a soft cloth and a paste furniture wax. Buff lightly so as not to remove the dark oxide coating.
US26	Polished Chrome Plated	Use a soft cloth and a good metal cleaner.
US26D	Satin Chrome Plated	Use a soft cloth and a good metal cleaner.
US28	Aluminum, Anodized	Use a soft cloth and mild soap and water.
US20A (313)	Aluminum, Dark Bronze Anodized	Use a soft cloth and mild soap and water.
US3	Polished Brass, Lacquered	Use a soft cloth and mild soap and water. Do not use brass polish or an abrasive cleaner unless you want to remove all lacquer and totally refinish the product.
US32	Polished Stainless Steel	Use a soft cloth and a good metal cleaner.
US32D	Satin Stainless Steel	Use a soft cloth and a good metal cleaner.
US4	Satin Brass, Lacquered	Use a soft cloth and mild soap and water. Do not use brass polish or an abrasive cleaner unless you want to remove all lacquer and totally refinish the product.
	All Painted Finishes	Use a soft cloth and mild soap and water.
